Various Scholarships Offered Through T.E.A.C.H.

Building Foundations Scholarship:

If you want to take an approved 3-4 credit course. This is an opportunity to meet the licensing requirements for annual training.

CDA Assessment Scholarship:

If you have completed the requirements for CDA. This scholarship helps with the assessment fee charged by the Council for Professional Recognition.

CDA Training Scholarship:

If you want to complete the CDA training requirements for college credit.

Associates Degree Scholarship:

If you want to earn an Associate's Degree in early childhood education or child development.

Bachelor's Degree Scholarship:

If you want to earn a Bachelor's Degree in early childhood education or child development.

Master's Degree Scholarship:

If you want to earn a Master's Degree in early childhood education or child development

Scholarship recipient is required to do the following listed below:

Michigan Association for the

Education of Young Children

- Attend classes and successfully complete the minimum contract requirements.
- Contribute a portion of the cost for required tuition and books.
- Agree to remain with his or her sponsoring employer or to the field of early childhood education for 6 months to one year after the completion of each contract.

For scholarships requiring a sponsor, the program agrees to:

- Contribute a portion of the cost of required tuition and books.
- Give eligible recipients paid release time for work to attend classes or study.
- Award the recipient a bonus or a raise upon completion of the contract requirements.

Eligibility Requirements:

- · Work a minimum of 20 hours per week in a
 - Licensed child care center, group home, or registered family home, or in an eligible workforce support position (Master's only)
- Meet income eligibility requirements
