Scholarships



Baker College offers scholarships for every kind of student: high school seniors, transfer students, new students, current students, undergraduate and graduate students. The following may be of particular interest to early childhood education students:

- Deans Scholarship: \$1,500/semester (\$4,500/yr. max.), up to 4 years
- Regents Scholarship: \$3,000/semester (\$9,000/yr. max.), up to 4 years
- Transfer Scholarship: \$1,500/semester (\$4,500/yr. max.), up to 3 years
- Trustees Transfer Scholarship: \$3,000/semester (\$9,000/yr. max.), up to 3 years
